



Goodrich-O'Brien Lake Recommended Wake Boat Area

Areas that are 500 feet from Shore and greater than 20 feet deep

Use of this area decreases shoreline impacts and resuspension of sediment
Be sure to fully treat or drain ballast and bilge water to prevent the spread of AIS

You are responsible for your wake – Be aware of other boaters and hazards

- Shoreline erosion, which results in
impaired water quality and property loss
- Damage to others property,
including docked boats.
- Hazards to public safety both on the
water and on shore
